CONCLUSION

In conclusion, the women in Shopaholic Ties the Knot novel such as; Becky, Suze, and Jane are described as women who have traditional traits characteristics. For example Becky, Becky is described in several narrations and dialogues as an empathy, dependent, untrustworthy, and passive woman but when Becky's characteristics are deconstructed Becky has feminist traits characteristics there are: loyal, active, independent, and rational. The characteristics of women in Shopaholic Ties the Knot novel are described in traditional traits but when this novel is analyzed with deconstruction theory, the characters itself are actually described in feminist traits, there are: loyal, active, independent, and rational.

The portrayal of women characters in the Shopaholic Ties the Knot novel can be compared to other women representation in previous literary works, that Traditional traits is had by women, it is represented especially in novel written by male. (Djajanegara, 2003). empathy, dependent, untrustworthy, and passive are several characteristics of traditional traits. But in this novel, the writer is a woman, she describes women have traditional characteristics. And after the characteristics of women in her novel is deconstructed, they can be seen as characters who have feminist traits characteristics, there are: loyal, active, independent, and rational.
