

ABSTRACT

HANDANU WISNU WINDUNATA. INFLUENCE GAME GROUP ON COOPERATION IN EXTRACURRICULAR FUTSAL TEAM MAN 14 JAKARTA. Thesis: Jakarta, Recreational Sports, Faculty of Sport Science, State University of Jakarta, in January 2016.

The purpose of this study was to determine the effect on the group game in extracurricular futsal team collaboration MAN 14 Jakarta. Research conducted at MAN 14 Jakarta. As for the research conducted in December 2015 through January 2016 semester Academic Year 2015/2016. The method used is a method of *pre-experiment* with *Test Pre* and *Post Test Design*. The population in this research is the students who take extra futsal. Samples are students who take extra futsal. 2015/2016 academic year as many as 30 students. In this research, collecting data using questionnaires instrument and analysis technique in this study using the technique t-test statistics.

The study states that the Gaming Group effect on teamwork in extracurricular futsal MAN 14 Jakarta. This is evident from the results of the data analysis of the initial test and final test cooperation of students were analyzed using t-test. From the analysis of the data obtained t value of 7.45. Further tested with t_{table} at the level of $\alpha = 0.05$ and a degree of freedom $n-1 = 30-1 = 29$, the value t_{table} amounted to 2.045, thus the value $t_{count} > t_{table}$ or $7.45 > 2.045$. With the proven value of $t_{count} > t_{table}$ value can be stated that the group games have an influence on extracurricular futsal team collaboration MAN 14 Jakarta.
