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Jodhi Prasetyo. RELATIONSHIP BETWEEN THE SCORE LIMITED AND ANXIETY OF ACHIEVEMENT athletes in archery EDUCATION CENTER TRAINING STUDENTS (PPLP) NATIONAL 2015.

This study aims to determine the relationship between a limited percentage score and the anxiety of the achievements of athletes in archery Student Training Education Center (PPLP) national in Ragunan. This study starts from the trial until the retrieval of data from months of research carried out on 3 October to 26 December 2015. The data collection was conducted in GOR Ragunan, South Jakarta.

The method used is the method of surveying techniques Limited test scores and questionnaires as research instrument in data collection. The sampling technique in this paper by using total sampling is a sampling technique used by researchers to retrieve data from all existing samples. Sample and the population is taken Student Athlete Training Centre for Education (PPLP) National with the number of 10 people.

Based on the results of the study it can be concluded the relationship between scores on achievement limited by 46.51%, the relationship between anxiety toward achievement of 40.19%, and the relationship between anxiety scores and limited to the athlete's performance of 65.28%.
