

ABSTRACT

This study was aimed at finding out whether there are differences of accomplishment between working children and non-working children in Sekolah MASTER Yayasan Bina Insan Mandiri Depok junior high school. The research was conducted at the Junior School MASTER on odd semester 2015/2016. This study uses *ex post facto*. Techniques used in data collection is by reviewing the documentation personal data of children's documents learners gained from class books leger in Sekolah MASTER junior high school. Data accomplishment of children obtained from first semester report cards. The sampling technique using propotionate random sampling for all children of junior high school students non working children and working children as a sample.

Data analyzes using t test (t-test) at significance level $\alpha = 0.05$ and obtained the value of t_{count} 4.75 and obtained t_{tabel} 4.00, then the value $t_{\text{count}} > t_{\text{table}}$ there are differences in accomplishment of non-working children is higher from working children, with the average value of scores of children in non-working children at 7.24 and the average score in children working at 6.28. The showed that there are significant accomplishment difference between of non-working children better than working children.
