

ABSTRACT

JIHAN SAFIRA. The Relationship Between Students Perception About School Environment and The Interest in Learning Social Studies of 8th Grade Students at Jakarta 109 Junior High School. Quantitative Research. Minithesis. Jakarta : Social Studies Educational Department, Faculty of Social Science, State University of Jakarta, 2016.

The purpose of this research is to collect the valid data and fact about the Relationship Between Students Perception of School Environment and The Interest in Learning Social Studies of 8th Grade Students Jakarta 109 Junior High School.

This research uses quantitative method. Sample used in this research in amount of 54 students. Samples were taken by proportionate random sampling technique.

The result of calculation shows that the regression equation is $\hat{Y} = 53,515 + 0,593X$. The result of normality calculation with Lilliefors Test obtained that $L_{count} (0,0709) < L_{table} (0,1205)$, so that the data has distributed normally. The result of homogeneity test obtained that $F_{count} (1,227) < F_{table} (1,577)$, so the variance of the sample is homogeneous. The regression significance test obtained that $F_{count} (15,871) > F_{table} (4,0266)$, so the regression is significant. Meanwhile, the linearity test result obtained that the calculation result is $F_{count} (1,533) < F_{table} (2,09)$, so the model of the regression equation is linear.

On product moment calculation obtained $r_{count} (0,483) > r_{table} (0,2632)$, so there is a positive relationship between X variable and Y variable. The result of correlational coefficient significance test on significance standard of 0,05 obtained $t_{hitung} (3,979) > t_{tabel} (1,674)$, so there is a significant relationship between X variable and Y variable. The coefficient of determination test obtained r_{xy}^2 in amount of 0,233 or about 23,3%. From the result we can interpret that the interest in learning social studies determined by student perception about school environment in amount of 23,3% and the rest 76,7% determined by other factors which not involved in this research.
