This essay used historical method which the data was acquired from literature and is served descriptively narrative. This essay explained about how civilian massacre at Rawagede, Karawang, West Java on December 9th, 1947 executed by Dutch's military. The reason that encouraged Dutch to execute this massacre was because Dutch's army could not find Captain Lukas Kustaryo, a partisan who had been long become dutch's fugitive was headquartered in Rawagede, they then execute civilian massacre with full of pique and caused 431 of men and women became the victims of it.

The methodological used in this essay is historical method which is divided into four steps which they are heuristics, critics, interpretation and historiography. The sources used in this essay consists of primary sources which were acquired from archives and secondary sources which were acquired from books related to the content of this essay.
