ABSTRACT

The aim of this study is to acquire knowledge based on empirical data or facts (valid), true and trustworthy (reliable) about a relationship of the perception of students about the standard of lecturers with motivation of students in writing a Skripsi. This study was done to pendidikan IPS alumnus unj, year 2010 and year 2011. This study is using correlational quantitative research, with ex post facto method (research after the incident). The sample is took randomly with the level of proportional.

The result of this study has the same simple linier regression $\hat{Y} = 30.403 + 0.796$ X. the correlation pearson the moment be obtained by $r_{xy} = 0.5104$, Which means there are positive relationships between freely variables (perception of students about the standard of lecturers) with tied variables (motivation of students in writing a thesis). Based on the calculation of the correlation or a t-test got t-count (3.357) > t-table (1.694), suggesting a perception relationship of students about the standard of lecturers with motivation of students in writing the thesis of coefficient of the correlation is 0.2605 with the determination of 26.05%.
