Analysis test the validity of the instrument using Pearson Product Moment with the help of software Statistical Package for the Social Sciences (SPSS) version 20.0. Test reliability with Cronbach alpha formula with the help of software Statistical Package for the Social Sciences (SPSS) version 20.0. to obtain the results of 0.890 which means that the instrument has high reliability and fit for use as a research instrument. The results showed 81.55% self-efficacy of career decision VIII grade students in junior high school (SMPN) 99 Jakarta middle category, 14.85% were in the low category, and 3.6% self-efficacy of career decision VIII grade students in junior high school (SMPN) 99 Jakarta is in the category at the high category. Characterized by the development of capacity, attitudes, interests, and needs related to self-concept. The self-concept of the individual is formed through the identification of the figures of the family and school environments.
