## **ABSTRACT**

High sociology learning. Normality test can be seen that the value of 0.861 greater than 0.05 so it can be concluded that the distribution of data normal. In a test of homogeneity is known that the significance of the outcome variable learning (Y) based on the students' perception variable (X) is 0.08 greater than 0.05 meaning that the variable Y based on the variable X has the same variants. Research hypothesis testing using the chi-square test Asymp.Sig value of 0.317. Because the value Asymp.Sig 0.317 greater than 0.05, it can be concluded that Ho accepted, which means there is no significant relationship between perception student learning outcomes. This can be interpreted to correlate student perceptions not earning outcomes.
