## **CHAPTER III**

#### Methodology

This chapter describes method, data, data source, and data collecting & analyzing procedures for analyzing construction of Liverpool identity in Jürgen Klopp post-match conferences.

## 3.1 Method

This research uses descriptive qualitative method with Halliday's Systemic Functional Linguistics approach to analyze the textual identity construction in Jürgen Klopp post-match conferences and theory of identity from Woodward to analyze the Liverpool identity construction.

## 3.2 Data & Source of Data

Data of this research are words/phrases/clauses from Jürgen Klopp's post-match conferences' transcripts from some matches as followed:

1.	Against Arsenal	(14 <sup>th</sup> August 2016)
2.	Against Hull City	(24 <sup>th</sup> September 2016)
3.	Against Bournemouth	(4 <sup>th</sup> December 2016)
4.	Against West Ham	(11 <sup>th</sup> December 2016)

# **3.3 Data Collecting Procedures**

- Select 4 matches from 38 matches of season 2016/2017 based on opening match of season & random results (win, lose, draw).
- 2. Browse transcripts of each match from liverpoolfc.com.
- 3. Collect transcripts.

## **3.4 Data Analysis Procedures**

1. Break sentences from the transcripts into clauses.

- Analyze the data with applying Halliday's transitivity system of Systemic Functional Linguistic.
- 4. Analyze the football strategy used in each matches.
- 5. Analyze how Jürgen Klopp constructs Liverpool identity by analyzing relation between Liverpool history, Liverpool present, and other clubs.
- 6. Draw conclusion.
