This research entitled Qualifying Adjective in The Roman titled *Les Aveux* by Martine Latulippe is intended as one of the requirements for graduation in French Language Education Studies Program, Faculty of Languages and Arts, State University of Jakarta. The purpose of this research is to understand the use of adjectives in French sentences contained in *Les Aveux* romance by Martine Latulippe.

It is a qualitative research using descriptive method. This research utilize qualitative data analysis technique by Miles and Huberman which is devised into three phases; data reduction, presentation and conclusion.

Data reduction is to sort out sentences containing qualified adjectives and to determine words attached to the adjectives in those sentences.

Then, the adjectives that have been found are then classified into two types of adjective; adjective épithète and attributes. The final stage is to draw conclusions about any qualifying adjective that is used in the following sentence and then verified using native speakers or the internet or other books explaining the type of adjective.

The results reveals that adjective épithète tend to be widely used in the roman, *Les Aveux*. From the results of this research, students are expected to understand and use adjectives in sentences either oral or written on French reading.
