

CHAPTER V

CONCLUSION

5.1 Conclusion

Based on the stated findings in the previous section, from the four songs of Muse's Drones Album, Muse used eight kinds of figurative language in their album. There are metaphor, simile, personification, symbol, hyperbole, synecdoche, paradox, and irony. From 43 figurative languages, there are 14 metaphors (25.5 %), 14 personifications (25.5 %), 8 hyperboles (14.5%), 6 synecdoche (10.9 %), 5 paradoxes (9.1 %), 4 symbols (7.3 %), 3 ironies (5.5 %), and 1 simile (1.8 %). Found in Muse's song lyrics.

Metaphor placed the first position because the songwriters want to lead the imagination of the listener to feel the emotions and feelings from the writer. Besides, in writing the song's lyrics the author must convey ideas and stories with solid sentences. Then, based on the object used, those metaphors going to a negative meaning to emphasize the idea of sneaking or criticizing someone or group of people that control the world in the songs. The negative meanings are referring to bad characterizations of a dictatorial and iron-handed form of leadership. Furthermore, Personification also has a same position with metaphor because the writer wants to make "The Drones" as the main object look alive since it has the ability to give inanimate objects and ideas of human qualities as if they can act like a human being.

By using figurative language, the listeners are challenged to imagine what they hear or read. The listener will be pleased when they hear the song because it creates imagination in their minds. The imagination brings a huge interest for the listeners to hear more and interpret the meaning behind the figurative language. People also judge the quality of a song from how well the songwriter uses figurative language. Because figurative language is a soul for the song's lyrics, and that makes the song will be more memorable for the listener. So, figurative language becomes a very useful tool in song's lyrics to make the readers' feeling or emotion to understanding the idea and messages better since it creates imagination that makes the song become more exciting and entertaining.

5.2 Suggestion

The writer suggests to English Department student to conduct another study in the field of figurative language and stylistic related with literary works such a novel, poetry, song, etc., In Figurative language field, the writer suggests to conduct a research that more narrowed to each figurative language. For example, the student can conduct a research about the metaphor in a piece of literary work since there are four kinds of metaphor. Those studies are still needed in our department and it is expected to improve our skills in both linguistic and literature field.
