## APPLICATION OF PHONETIC TO INCREASE AWARENESS OF SPEAKING AT THE DEAF STUDENTS IN CLASS VI

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## **ABSTRACT**

The purpose of this research is to increase awareness of speaking through applying of phonetics at the deaf students in the class VI SLB BC Cempaka Putih. The subjects were grade VI deaf students being in Cempaka Putih SLB BC by 6 students. The method used in this study is action research. This study was conducted by 2 cycles, each cycle using the action procedure action planning, action, observation, and reflection. Data analysis in this research study completed using the calculation, which results in an increase in the percentage of learning outcomes, researchers have established a minimum of 70% completeness criteria for beginning speaking skills students. Before taking action the first cycle, the researcher held a pre-test to obtain initial data. Data pre-test results for beginning speaking skills students acquire reading below 70% means stills below the prescribed minimum completeness. After doing research on the class action the end of cycle 2 data showed that all subjects have obtained scores between 70% to 80% means it has met the criteria of completeness. The conclusion of this study is that the applying phonetic can increase awareness speaking at the deaf students beginning being SLB BC Cempaka Putih in Central Jakarta.
