ABSTRAC

MEILIZA. Student Teacher Attitudes Against Cheating In SMAN 45 Jakarta Utara. (A Survey Conducted At high school teacher in North Jakarta District 45). Thesis. Jakarta: Department of Guidance and Counselling Faculty of Education, State University of Jakarta, 2011.

This study aims to obtain an overview of teachers' attitudes toward cheating behavior of students at SMA 45 Jakarta Utara. The study population consists of 50 teachers with a sampling technique the sample census taker. The research was conducted from November until July 2011.

The research method used is deskripstif research methods. The data collection is done by using a questionnaire or a questionnaire enclosed in the form of Likert scales with four alternate answer choices that contain 60 items. Test the validity of the instrument is done by using the Product Moment. Validity of test results in consultation with the r tables for 0279, while for the reliability test using Cronbach alpha and 0.91 obtained with the categorization is very high.

Research data using descriptive statistics, ie by calculating the average, minimum value, maximum value, range, standard deviation, variance, and median. In addition, the data also visualized by using distribution tables and images.

The results showed that the attitudes of teachers toward students who cheat in SMAN 45 Jakarta Utara is a negative point is the attitude of teachers do not support students who are cheating, that is equal to 96% by the number of respondents 48 teachers. While in the Positive category by 4% by the number of respondents 2 teachers. Persentase highest Positive behavioral limits contained in the indicators of cheating by 10% by the respondents five teachers.

The implications of this research is to make rules and sanctions are very effective for teachers who do not support students who cheating resul this study can be one of the initial data to conduct a more in-depth survey of the attitudes of teachers toward students who cheat in SMAN 45 Jakarta Utara.
