

ABSTRACT

BAYU FEBRIANSYAH. 4315072159. House Wives Who Work In KUB Contribution Concerning In Fisherman Family Welfare At Village Level Cikahuripan Sukabumi District. Thesis, Jakarta: Department of Geography, Faculty of Social Sciences, State University of Jakarta, 2013.

This research aim to acknowledge the contribution of the house wives who work in KUB concerning the level of fisherman families welfare at Village Level Cikahuripan Sukabumi District. The duration of this research was implemented for about 2 months since November to December 2012.

This research used descriptive method with survey approach. 50 respondents from the KUB workers were being used as sample of this research. Data collective techniques use inquiry and observation. Welfare indicator that being used in this research (according BKKBN) are basic needs, social psychology needs, development needs and self-actualization needs. According to those categories and then will be categorized into pre-welfare family, welfare family step I, welfare family step II, welfare family step III, welfare family step III PLUS. Data analysis technique that being used in this research is percentage and being analyzed descriptively.

So, according to this research shows that 58% from house wives contribution implied in high contribution level, 42% implied in medium contribution level. The aspect of working house wives : duration of working, respondents who work for 8-10 years as much 56%, and their income which less than Rp 300.000 as much 54%, husband's income for about Rp 500.000 - Rp.1000.000 as much 58%, working hours respondents as rate 66%. Whole respondents income allocation for family as much 66%, income usage for children education cost as much 42%, for saving 30% and for daily food for about 24%.

Welfare level: family respondents as rate of 8% are in family welfare step II, 76% in category of welfare family step III and 16% implied in category of welfare family step III PLUS, which is a family that afford to fill welfare indicators as basic needs, socio-pyscological needs, development needs, and also self-actualization. Although there are few needs that still unfulfilled as material contribution which is given to social activities tentatively.
