ABSTRACT

This development was to produce a module "Basic Concepts of Training Performance Evaluation" for training participants of "Training Performance Evaluation" in Education and Training Department, Ministry of Home Affairs. This development refers to the model of product development belongs to Derek Rowntree. Development procedure consists of three (3) phases, including planning stage 1, stage 2 preparation for writing, and writing and editing stage 3. In all these stages, in which there are steps that must be passed first in order to proceed to the next stage. Evaluation of the product that is developed only through expert review evaluation involving subject matter experts, media specialists, and instructional design experts. In this evaluation resulted in a score, among others, from subject matter experts by 3.13, 3.18 by media experts, and instructional design from the experts resulted in a score of 3.1. With the results of these scores, the products made are included in both categories. As for the results, they should be evaluated for other aspects. However, in the development of this module, the researcher simply evaluating expert review.
