

CHAPTER V

CONCLUSION AND SUGGESTION

5.1 Conclusion

In conveying the value of humanity, humans can express it through a variety of media, such as novels, short stories, poetry, films, advertising, song lyric and so on. One medium considered as beautiful and has a high aesthetic value is through song lyric. It contains meaningful words and signs to be conveyed to listeners.

Considering the number of international musicians and singers in over the world, the writer is interested in and selects songs from the album of Humanitarian singer, namely Michael Heart. The songs of Michael Heart which are selected from his singles are considered relevant for this study. The writer takes four songs to be used as the data source of this study from thirteen songs contained in his first album.

The selected four songs are considered to have significant lyrics to represent the other songs in revealing expression of the value of humanity. The four song lyrics contain a lot of words, phrases, clauses, or sentences that signify and associate with how to express the value of humanity. The four song lyrics come from Michael Heart songs entitled *We Will Not Go Down*, *Freedom*, *Help Is On The Way* and *What About Us*.

Using Roland Barthes semiotic theory and correlating them with the theories of the value of humanity, it can be concluded that four song lyrics of

Michael Heart portray the value of humanity. Further, the result of the analysis shows that the four songs portrayed expression of the value of humanity in several ways.

In the first song lyric, entitled *We Will Not Go Down*, expression of the value of humanity is portrayed by saying '**we will not go down**' which is described about how strong togetherness, people bond, empathy and resistance movement for injustice in Gaza, Palestine. Then, this song lyric portrays the type of the value of humanity is human problems in relation to other human beings. Moreover, this song lyrics portrays how the value of humanity can help humans to be more aware in life.

In the second song lyric, there is *Freedom*. This song lyric portrays expression of human right by saying '**we want freedom**' which is described about how human's faith against the tyranny in Middle East Country such as Saudi Arabia, Syria and etc. That situation is called Arab Spring. The same type with the first song portrayed human problems in relation to other human beings.

The third selected song lyric *Help Is On The Way* describes the same feeling and empathy with the earthquake victims in Haiti by saying '**we feel the ground shaking beneath your feet**'. The song contains the sense of human nature. In persons issues in relation to the human nature can be tangible actions in processing and managing the natural resource that can provide food for human life. It can be shown in the form of man's dependence on natural resources has implications for the embodiment of culture.

The fourth song lyric is *What About Us*. This song lyric portrays expression to encourage to take an action against the war in Syria by saying '**should we just**

keep on dying'. The action which can build the human existence against injustice and to take apart of it. Then, this song lyric portrays the type of the value of humanity that is human problems in relation to other human beings.

5.2 Recommendation

Literary works should not be separated from humanity as contained in the four song lyrics of Michael Heart that have been analysed. Further, four song lyrics of Michael Heart are selected due to portrayal of the value of humanity through words. Furthermore, if further researchers eagerly want to analyse the same topic, it is suggested by using linguistic theory approach. Thus, the result of the study could be able to complete the deficiencies found in previous study and to inspire other researchers to study more literary works containing humanity values.
