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**ABSTRACT**

*This study aims to describe social anxiety in the first-year students Batch 2021 of Faculty of Psychology Education at the State University of Jakarta.*

*This study uses a descriptive quantitative approach. This study selects a sample of 114 respondents using purposive sampling technique. The social anxiety instrument used in this study is the Social Anxiety Scale for Adolescents (SAS-A) consisting of 22 items with reliability of 0.881 that is calculated by using IBM SPSS Statistics 22 software with Cronbach's Alpha reliability test.*

*The result of this study shows that there are 58 respondents (50.9 percent) who have low-levels of social anxiety, while 56 other respondents (49.1 percent) have high-levels of social anxiety. It illustrates that most of the first-year students Batch 2021 of Faculty of Psychology Education at the State University of Jakarta have low-levels of social anxiety.*
