

ABSTRACT

ANNISA AMTARI, *Parenting Parents in Children SMP 243 Jakarta (Case Study Phenomenon "Hang out" in Children SMP)* Thesis, Jakarta: Education Department of Social Sciences, Faculty of Social Sciences, State University of Jakarta, in 2015.

This study aims to determine parenting applied by parents to children / students who often make a habit of hanging out after school with regard to the phenomenon where hanging out around 243 schools in Jakarta.

The author uses qualitative methods in order to get a more in depth data to dig to the informant research. Source of data obtained using interviews, observation, and literature. Source of data in this study is derived from key informants stall owners and six parents, while the core informants are six students who often hang out tradition.

The results of this study concluded that parents' parenting each child is different for every child also has different properties and characteristics that must be handled in a different way. This study found three types of parenting that is applied by the parent, the Democratic Parenting, Permissive Parenting and Parenting Authoritarian. Democratic parenting style is very dominant in this study, most children who often tradition to hang out is a child with a democratic parenting style adopted by his parents. And the results of this study also revealed that the cause of the students hanging out diverse, there are because they feel saturated, there were only followed his friends and there is a feeling of loneliness due to family members who do not complete and bustle of other family members. The pattern of parent-child interaction is good, and most parents apply democratic parenting is parenting that is applied to prioritize the interests of the children that are rational
