CHAPTER V

CONCLUSION

5.1. Conclusion

The result of the transgender portrayal in Indonesia, on The Jakarta Post online newspaper is that the transgender people is portrayed as rejected people and dangerous for the society. In the news article it is explicitly seen that transgender are rejected in the society, they are not allowed to apply for job in the office, they are rejected in their own neighborhood. They are also seen as dangerous, because people think that being transgender is a disease, and being a transgender means that they can transmit sexual disease.

Furthermore, all types of attitude sub-systems such as; affect, judgement, and appreciation are implied in the news articles on The Jakarta Post that have been analyzed. The results reveal that there are, 24% of affect (16%positive and 8%negative), 64%judgement (15%positive and 64%negative), and 12%appreciation (10%positive and 2%negative). The engagement subsystem such as monogloss, and heterogloss are also analyzed in the 6 news articles. There are 51% monogloss, and 49% of heterogloss. The most used source is monogloss, which means the author mostly makes their own opinion about transgender or LGBT community. For the graduation subsystem, there are 89% of force, and 11% of focus. Considering the

number of the percentage, judgement with negative value, monogloss, and force have become the most used sub-system in the analysis. Therefore, it can be concluded that the author of the Jakarta Post who writes the news about transgender from January 2019 to November 2019 use a lot of their opinion about transgender with using negative words that describe their behavior, or their situation.

5.2. Recommendation

Media is a very large place to be a source of information, and it is also useful for an English literature student to do some research. There are a lot of things to be analyzed in the world of media, or inside the media itself, such as the news. One of the theories that can help English literature students to use media as their source of the data is Appraisal system.

In using media as the source of our information, we have to be careful for media sometimes create and leading opinions towards an object. Though the media itself has to be fair in serving information about a person, community, or other objects. To help us using media as the tool of our research or as the source of research we also have another support, such as relevant books and journals.
